Comments: Characteristics: Expresses a constitutively active over-expressed Gs-coupled GPCR (Dexorgen)., Characteristics: Expresses a modified cyclic nucleotide gated (CNG) channel that opens in response to elevated intracellular cAMP levels and consequently result in ion flux and cell membrane depolarization. Allows sensitive detection of signaling by Gs, Gi or Gq-coupled receptors (Dexorgen).
