Comments: Discontinued; manufacturer recommendations: Preliminary experiments gave an approx 28kDa band in Rat Testis lysates after 1µg/ml antibody staining. Please note that currently we cannot find an explanation in the literature for the band we observe given the calculated size of 20.9kDa according to Human NP_620167.1 and of 21.8kDa according to Rat XP_001066918.2 . The 28kDa band was successfully blocked by incubation with the immunizing peptide. We would appreciate any feedback from people in the field - have any results been reported with other antibodies/lysates? Have any further splice variants/modified forms been reported? ELISA.; ELISA
