Comments: Discontinued; manufacturer recommendations: ELISA; ELISA. Preliminary experiments gave bands at approx 50kDa and 35kDa in Human Adipose lysates after 0.1µg/ml antibody staining. Please note that currently we cannot find an explanation in the literature for the bands we observe given the calculated size of 180kDa according to NP_002327.2. Both detected bands were successfully blocked by incubation with the immunizing peptide (and BLAST results with the immunizing peptide sequence did not identify any other proteins to explain the additional bands). We would appreciate any feedback from people in the field - have any results been reported with other antibodies/lysates? Have any further splice variants/modified forms been reported? This antibody is expected to recognise an epitope corresponding to aa 1546-1560 of human LRP6
