Notes: At the Center for Experimental Plants and Animals, Hokkaido University, LEC, along with LEA, was established from a closed colony of Long-Evans rats obtained from Kobe University in 1975. In 1984, within the LEC rats of their F24 generation, a rat exhibiting spontaneous hepatitis with severe jaundice was found (Yoshida, 1987). The LEC was available from Charles River Japan, Inc., Kanagawa, as of spring, 1991.
