Notes: F30A10.6. Homozygous lethal deletion chromosome balanced by bli-4- and GFP-marked translocation. Heterozygotes are WT with pharyngeal GFP signal, and segregate WT GFP, arrested hT2 aneuploids, and non-GFP ok1602 homozygotes (mid-larval arrest). Homozygous hT2[bli-4 let-? qIs48] inviable. Pick WT GFP and check for correct segregation of progeny to maintain. External left primer: GTAATGGCTCCTTGCTCAGG. External right primer: CCGAACCGCAAGTTGTTTAT. Internal left primer: GTCACAGCTAATGGGAGCGT. Internal right primer: AACTCAACAGGATCCCTCCA. Internal WT amplicon: 3044 bp. Deletion size: 745 bp. Deletion left flank: CTTGTAAATCAAAAAGGAAGAGAGAAAAAA.
