Pick WT GFP and check for correct segregation of progeny to maintain. External left primer: CGGAGGATAGTTTGCAGGAG. External right primer: CTCTTCCCCTCCGATACCTC. Internal left primer: AGCTGCAGTCAGAAGTGGGT. Internal right primer: AATCCCAGTTTCTCGCCTTT. Internal WT amplicon: 2753 bp.
