Notes: D2089.1, D2089.2. Homozygous lethal deletion chromosome balanced by GFP- and dpy-10-marked inversion. Heterozygotes are WT with relatively dim pharyngeal GFP signal, and segregate WT dim GFP, Dpy bright GFP (mIn1 homozygotes), and non-GFP ok2079 homozygotes (early larval arrest). Pick WT dim GFP and check for correct segregation of progeny to maintain. External left primer: GAAATTACGTCGCCGGTTTA. External right primer: CACTGTTTTTCGGAGCCAAT. Internal left primer: ACATTTTCGACATCGGCTACC. Internal right primer: CACCTCAACTTATTCGGGGA. Internal WT amplicon: 3201 bp. Deletion size: 1429 bp. Deletion left flank: TAAGCCATTTCTCGAAGAAAACAAAGCACA.
