Notes: C30F8.2. Homozygous lethal deletion chromosome balanced by bli-4- and GFP-marked translocation. Heterozygotes are WT with pharyngeal GFP signal, and segregate WT GFP, arrested hT2 aneuploids, and non-GFP ok2332 homozygotes (probable embryonic arrest). Homozygous hT2[bli-4 let-? qIs48] inviable. Pick WT GFP and check for correct segregation of progeny to maintain. External left primer: CCAGATCCAGGAAGGAATGA. External right primer: CGAAAATAATTGCAGCCCAT. Internal left primer: TTGCGAAGCCGATTTAGTTT. Internal right primer: TTCTTTCGCCTCCTTTTCA. Internal WT amplicon: 2112 bp. Deletion size: 831 bp. Deletion left flank: TTTCGAAAAACCAGGCCGTAAACTGACAGC.
