Notes: F48C1.7. Homozygous sterile deletion chromosome balanced by bli-4- and GFP-marked translocation. Heterozygotes are WT with pharyngeal GFP signal, and segregate WT GFP, arrested hT2 aneuploids, and non-GFP ok2213 homozygotes (sterile, lays unfertilized oocytes). Homozygous hT2[bli-4 let-? qIs48] inviable. Pick WT GFP and check for correct segregation of progeny to maintain. External left primer: ACTGGGTGCAAAACAGGTTC. External right primer: GGCTTACAGCTCTTGGTGGA. Internal left primer: GACCAAATTGAAGCGCATTT. Internal right primer: GAACATTTTTCCGTCAACCG. Internal WT amplicon: 2133 bp. Deletion size: 1051 bp. Deletion left flank: TGGGATGAATTTATGTGCAACATGCTCGTA.
