Pick WT GFP and check for correct segregation of progeny to maintain. External left primer: ATTTTTCGGCAAACCTGCAAG. External right primer: AAAAATTGGAATCGGCTTGA. Internal left primer: GCCATTTCTTTGTTTTCAACG. Internal right primer: AAGCCCTGCTTGATTTCTCCTC. Internal WT amplicon: 1147 bp. Deletion size: 642 bp. Deletion left flank: AACGACACCACATTCTCGGTCAGAGCCGCG.
