Notes: K04G7.4. Homozygous lethal deletion chromosome balanced by bli-4- and GFP-marked translocation. Heterozygotes are WT with pharyngeal GFP signal, and segregate WT GFP, arrested hT2 aneuploids, and non-GFP ok2483 homozygotes (early- to mid-larval arrest). Homozygous hT2[bli-4 let-? qIs48] inviable. Pick WT GFP and check for correct segregation of progeny to maintain. External left primer: AAAACCCAAACGTGGCAATA. External right primer: TTGTTAAGACCATCATGCCG. Internal left primer: AAAAGTGTGCGTGGGGTAAT. Internal right primer: GTTCCATGAGCAAATTGGGA. Internal WT amplicon: 3154 bp. Deletion size: 1295 bp. Deletion left flank: TCTATTACTTAAAGCAAATTTTCAAATTGA.
