Heterozygotes are WT, and segregate WT, arrested mT1 aneuploids, sterile Dpys (mT1 homozygotes), and ok3162 homozygotes (arrest stage/phenotype undetermined). Pick WT and check for correct segregation of progeny to maintain. External left primer: ATACCCAACAGCAGGCACTC. External right primer: TTCGACAATTCCGTCATCAA. Internal left primer: TGTTACCTCAAAAGTCAAGGCT. Internal right primer: CGATTGGTTAGAGAACGGGA. Internal WT amplicon: 1204 bp. Deletion size: 794 bp. Deletion left flank: ACGTTTGGAGCTCGCTGGATCATTGCTTTC. Deletion right flank: TGGTGAAAGCCGTCAGAGATTGAGAAGGT.
