Heterozygotes are WT with relatively dim pharyngeal GFP signal, and segregate WT dim GFP, Dpy bright GFP (mIn1 homozygotes), and non-GFP ok3709 homozygotes (early- to mid-larval arrest). Pick WT dim GFP and check for correct segregation of progeny to maintain. External left primer: TCGTCTTTCAATCCGAGACC. External right primer: ATGGGCGATCGAGTTTTGTC. Internal left primer: GGCAGAAACACCAACGATCT. Internal right primer: AAAAAGCCACGGAAAGTTGA. Internal WT amplicon: 1104 bp. Deletion size: 592 bp. Deletion left flank: TCCGAAGGCGTAGTATTTTCCGTCTTCTCC. Deletion right flank: CTTCTTCCTTCTCTACACCTTCCGCGGGA.
