Internal right primer: CCCCCATAATTTTCATATCACG. Internal WT amplicon: 1298 bp. Deletion size: 1022 bp. Deletion left flank: TCATTTTTATTTGAATCATCAACTTTTAAA. Deletion right flank: AGCTCAAGATGAAAAAAGAAAAAGAGCAGG.
