Notes: F52F12.1. Homozygous lethal deletion chromosome balanced by bli-4- and GFP-marked translocation. Heterozygotes are WT with pharyngeal GFP signal, and segregate WT GFP, arrested hT2 aneuploids, and non-GFP ok3339 homozygotes (early larval arrest). Homozygous hT2[bli-4 let-? qIs48] inviable. Pick WT GFP and check for correct segregation of progeny to maintain. External left primer: CATATGCCTCGTCCTGGAAC. External right primer: GGCCATGTTTCATCAGAAGGT. Internal left primer: TTTCTTTACCACGAAGTAAGCG. Internal right primer: TCTGAATGTTTGAAAGTCGCA. Internal WT amplicon: 1354 bp. Deletion size: 696 bp. Deletion left flank: CATTGAAGTAGAGGCCAAACAACGAAATAT.
